These instructions accompanying the product are the original instructions. This document is part of the product, keep it for the life of the product passing it on to any subsequent holder of the product. Read all these instructions before assembling, operating or maintaining this product.

1. SPECIFICATION

1.1 SCOPE

Special EPDM seals and gaskets material allows for use with: high temperature water, glycol, detergents, acid, organic and inorganic bleaching agents and hydraulic oils.

2. HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

2.1 GENERAL SAFETY WARNINGS

MARNING: READ and UNDERSTAND the Owner's Manual completely before using these sprayers.

The user must always ask the dealer for the safety card of the chemical product to be used, also for disposal of the residual liquid. The use of substances not in conformity with the current regulations is at the user's risk and peril.



Never open the pump when under pressure.



Do not eat, drink or smoke during use.



Do not leave the sprayer exposed to heat sources or intense cold.



Do not spray on windy days.



Do not use for spraying food products (wine, milk, etc.).



Wash hands and face after use.



Do not spray toxic or harmful liquids on persons, animals or foodstuffs.



Do not leave the pump within the reach of children.



Use suitable protection equipment during use.



During use make sure no one is near the sprayer.

NOTE: After use, rinse the container then operate the pump with clean water to completely empty the container and piston.

4. UNPACKING & CHECKING

4.1 PACKAGING

Carefully remove the product from the packaging and examine it for any sign of damage that may have happened during shipping. Lay the contents out and check them against the parts shown below. If any part is damaged or missing; please contact the Draper Helpline (the telephone number appears on the Title page) and do not attempt to use the product.


The packaging material should be retained at least during the guarantee period: in case the machine needs to be returned for repair.

Warning! Some of the packaging materials used may be harmful to children. Do not leave any of these materials in the reach of children.

If any of the packaging is to be thrown away, make sure they are disposed of correctly; according to local regulations.

4.2 WHAT'S IN THE BOX?

There are a number of parts in the box which need to be assembled.



- 6 Lance
- 7 Connector arm
- 8 Carry strap

- 9 Split pins
- (10) Strap lock


5.1 INSTALLATION - FIGS. 1 - 7

Please read this operating instruction carefully and observe the notes given. Use these instructions to familiarize yourself with the Backpack sprayer, its proper use and the notes on safety. For safety reasons, children and young people under 16 as well as anyone not familiar with these operating instructions may not use the backpack sprayer.

Unscrew the filter cap ②, in the filter you will find the split pins ③ and the strap lock ①.




Pull each unstitched end of the carrying strap approx. 2 to 3 cm through the plastic buckles.



Pull the looped end of carrying strap (8) through the opening under the carrying handle so that the strap adjuster is at the front. (Ensure the rubber shoulder pads are the correct way up).

Push the strap lock (10) sideways into the carrying strap loop.

Pull back the carrying strap until the strap lock prevents the carrying strap from sliding out.




NOTE: Before laying the sprayer down:

Make sure the cap is closed and place the sprayer on a flat and even surface.


ASSEMBLY

Slide the metal buckles onto the lugs at the base of the tank, until you hear them click into place.


NOTE: If you are right-handed the pump lever should be on the left-hand side so that you can hold the spray lance in your right hand.




The longer end of the of the connector bar ⑦ is pushed through hole in the top of piston head, then secured with one of the split pins supplied.



The other end goes through the pump arm (5) as shown, then secured in place with the 2nd split pin.



Slide the lance (6) into the trigger assembly (4), then screw together.



6. OPERATION

Thoroughly stir the chemicals to be used, unscrew the tank cap, pour in the product up to the highest mark (always comply with the precautionary measures and correct dosage specified by the product manufacturer).

Fit the tank cap and screw tight by hand (do not use pliers).

Strap the backpack sprayer to your back, adjust the length of the carrying straps as required using the strap adjusters (The stitched end of the carrying strap is threaded through the strap adjusters at the factory).

Press down the pump lever repeatedly (approx. 7-9 times) until it becomes more difficult to press the lever and you feel resistance.

Press the trigger on the sprayer handle, the Backpack sprayer starts to spraying.

Release the button on the sprayer handle, the backpack sprayer stops spraying.

7. MAINTENANCE

CLEANING THE BACKPACK SPRAYER:

Press the trigger on the sprayer handle to release the pressure remaining through the lance.

Unscrew tank cap, if the outside of the cap is dirty, thoroughly clean the area around the thread and thread O-ring.

Clean the inlet filter and tank cap in clean water.

Empty the tank and fill with clean water (with detergent added to the water if necessary).

Spray the water out of the backpack sprayer until the tank is empty (This cleans the nozzle and valves).

Leave the backpack sprayer open and allow it to dry.

CLEANING THE FILTER IN THE SPRAYER HANDLE:

Unscrew the union nut and pull the hose with filter out of the sprayer handle.

Rinse the filter under running water and reattach the sprayer handle.

CI FANING THE PUMP:

If the pump does not provide pressure after cleaning your backpack sprayer you must also clean the pump.

Push out the locking ring (using a screwdriver, for example) and pull the joint rod out of the pump.

Unscrew the union ring and pull out the pump.

Inspect the pump O-ring and install a new O-ring if necessary.

Pull out the inner part of the pump and the gasket.

Clean all pump parts and gaskets with water (and detergent).

Reassemble the pump in the reserve order.

NOTE: When assembling the pump ensure that the pump gaskets are seated properly after installation and are not squashed.

At least once a year clean pump thoroughly, re-grease or lubricate all moving parts.

WARNING:

When assembling and servicing, carefully insert the pump piston without forcing, so as not to damage the gasket.


